Who We Are

Calgary Communities Against Sexual Abuse is the primary agency in the city that specializes in working with sexual assault and sexual abuse. We know this issue affects individuals, families and communities from every area and every walk of life in our city. Because of this, we believe everyone needs to be involved in finding solutions.

CCASA values the diversity of people. We believe that every person has something important to contribute to our community, and that our differences make us richer as a society. We also believe that violence begins when some members of society don't see diversity as a strength.

Volunteer training

Sexual abuse and sexual assault is complex and sensitive in nature, so we offer our volunteers training to help them feel confident and comfortable with the issue.

Our first training session introduces volunteers to CCASA's philosophies and services, and gives insight into the ways in which people can make a difference in their community.

Additional sessions provide volunteers with tips and tools that will allow them to work with survivors of sexual violence, and their support people, and to speak about the issue in their communities. These sessions include information about:

- Understanding why violence happens
- How sexual violence affects everyone
- How to support survivors, their friends and family
- Challenging myths and beliefs about sexual violence
- The most important messages to share with your community

Services offered by CCASA:

24-hour Support and Information Line

This is available to anyone who is dealing with or affected by sexual abuse. This includes survivors, their friends or family, support people and professionals.

Sexual Assault Response Team (S.A.R.T.)

This service is part of the Connect Family and Sexual Abuse Network. We provide specialized services to individuals who have been sexually assaulted within the past 72 hours.

Education and Training

Raising awareness in the community by providing presentations and professional development training.

P.A.C.E.S. (Police and Court Education and Support Program)

Provides information, education and support about the justice system for survivors and their families.

Crisis Intervention and Support Counseling

Individual counselling for anyone affected by various forms of sexual abuse and sexual assault. For survivors, family, friend and support people.

Group Counseling

Sessions offer survivors support and counseling in a group setting.
