

Calgary Communities Against Sexual Abuse Response on the Dr. Aubrey Levin Appeal.

In response to the appeal awarded Dr. Aubrey Levin and a release on house arrest for the sexual assault conviction of 3 survivors under his care Calgary Communities Against Sexual Abuse (CCASA) is appalled and outraged that this could even transpire. "As an organization that sees firsthand the impact that sexual violence has on survivors, it is so upsetting to see a system that supports the offender, and minimizes what these victims went through and are still going through on a daily basis" says CCASA Executive Director, Danielle Aubry.

"These men were perpetrated on by Levin who had complete control over the direction of their lives and sadly it is Levin who is walking away most unscathed. This is unjust, and as an agency, we will stand up to support those men who were so brave to come forward in the first place."
