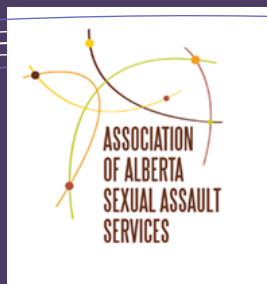
First Responder to Sexual Assault and Abuse Training
