Responsibilities of the therapist include:

- Providing trauma specialized counselling to individuals impacted by sexual violence
- Completing comprehensive needs and risk assessments
- Crisis Intervention
- Completing required documentation in a timely manner
- Advocacy for clients as needed
- Group counselling
- Providing support and crisis intervention to individuals accessing the Calgary Sexual Assault Response Team (CSART)

*Successful candidates will be required to work occasional evenings and weekends and may be needed to provide counselling to rural areas surrounding Calgary.

The successful applicants will have the following **qualifications**:

- A degree in social/human services with a minimum of 2-3 years related work experience; Master's degree preferred
- Experience providing individual counselling, including maintaining a clinical caseload
- Possess an anti-oppressive/feminist analysis of sexual violence
- Understanding of biopsychosocial causes and impacts of trauma
- Experience with crisis intervention
- Strong assessment and interpersonal communication skills
- Experience working with the effects of sexual violence on individuals and communities
- The ability to collaborate with various community and professional services
- Knowledge of Alberta College of Social Workers Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice
- Professional registration
